# Quaderni IRCrES is a series of the Research Institute on Sustainable Economic Growth

High quality research in the field of sustainable development

The series <u>Quaderni IRCrES</u> is open to national and international debate on sustainability in any fields of application. This series intends to make available to the scientific community a certified and completely open access platform for in-depth studies and agile dissemination.

The series <u>Quaderni IRCrES</u> accepts proposals for original studies (monographs, miscellanies,...) and proceedings of workshops, seminars or congresses organized by <u>CNR-IRCrES</u>, as far as these are connected with the fields of activity of the Institute. Interdisciplinary approaches on the topics of economic, social, cultural and environmental sustainability are welcomed.

In order to publish on <u>Quaderni IRCrES</u> one must submit an editorial project to the Scientific Committee of the Series at <u>redazione@ircres.cnr.it</u> using the appropriate <u>form</u>. The project must describe the topic/objective and provide a brief introduction to the various contributions, in the language of the text. The Scientific Committee will respond within 15 days after receiving the proposal.

Once the editorial project is approved, the final version of the text must be sent to redazione@ircres.cnr.it. It must respect the series format and comply with the criteria of the Editorial Guidelines. Before publication, contents will be double blind peer reviewed.

Clarity and readability of the texts as well as accurate research and analysis are held in high regard.

The accepted languages are Italian, English and French.

The texts that do not respect the requested format will not be accepted. Any editing is in charge of the authors.

The series has got its ISSN code; each volume has got its ISBN code; each essay or chapter has got their DOI if they can be cited independently.

#### **Intellectual Property Rights and Open Access**

The authors maintain the intellectual property of the works published in the series <u>Quaderni</u> <u>IRCrES</u>.

All published contributions are open access, under a Creative Commons licence (BY NC SA).

### Quaderni IRCrES must include

- $\checkmark$  Title in the language of the text and in English
- ✓ Editor(s), if any
- $\checkmark$  Author(s) of the texts and their affiliation(s)
- ✓ Abstract (for each contribution. It must briefly describe the topic/objective in English)

✓ Keywords (max. five keywords in English, separated by commas).

#### The text and/or its parts

- $\checkmark$  must be written according to the requested format,
- ✓ must respect the <u>Editorial Guidelines</u> available on the <u>CNR-IRCrES</u> website,
- $\checkmark$  must provide references.

References must include all cited texts, according to APA style. The author/editor must ensure that all references in the References section are also cited in the text using the "author-data" system (e.g., Voltaire, 1763).

Any editing is in charge of the authors.
