2017 - present	I'm the co-founder and coordinator of the Scientific Committee of “Nonna Roma”, a non-profit organization based in Rome (Italy), founded on May 2017 and run by a group of young activists of the Pigneto neighborhood.

The aim of the Association is to create a community of mutual assistance, connecting needs to resources and, above all, people with each other. The association focuses specifically on food and access to basic necessities. It was initially established as a food bank with a redistributive purpose, collecting unsold items from local businesses and providing them free of charge to those in need. Over the course of five years, the number of families involved has grown from 20 to 5,000, including Italians, resident foreigners, and migrants living below the absolute poverty line. Each family is assisted with a specific project in coordination with municipal social services. Starting with food as a point of access and interception of the community's needs, the association has activated a network of services around individuals, from popular education schools to health orientation desks and legal assistance. It has also launched a social incubator with the goal of supporting and coordinating the initial self-entrepreneurial initiatives of its users, providing assistance in fundraising, training courses, and business tutoring. In addition to food and employment, the association advocates for the right to housing, providing legal support to its users against evictions and organizing housing solutions for those in need. It also regularly organizes cultural events and sports activities open to all, such as a children's carnival parade, a solidarity lunch on the occasion of Liberation Day, a popular football tournament, and an open-air film festival in a neighborhood square.

The Scientific Committee is responsible for social research, political and legal analysis within the Association, with the dual objective of (1) informing the Board of Directors and assisting it in the planning of social activities and (2) promoting political advocacy actions, public inquiries, motions, and petitions aimed at changing the regulatory framework and implementing policies and institutional interventions to fight poverty and inequality.
